Dear Mr. Grassman,

In August 2012, Great Lakes Archaeological Research Center, Inc. conducted an archaeological and historical site and property search for the Janesville Certified Industrial Site, HWY 11 and Beloit Ave/CTH G (Figure 1). The archival search determined that there are no previously recorded archaeological sites or historic properties within or adjacent to the project area.

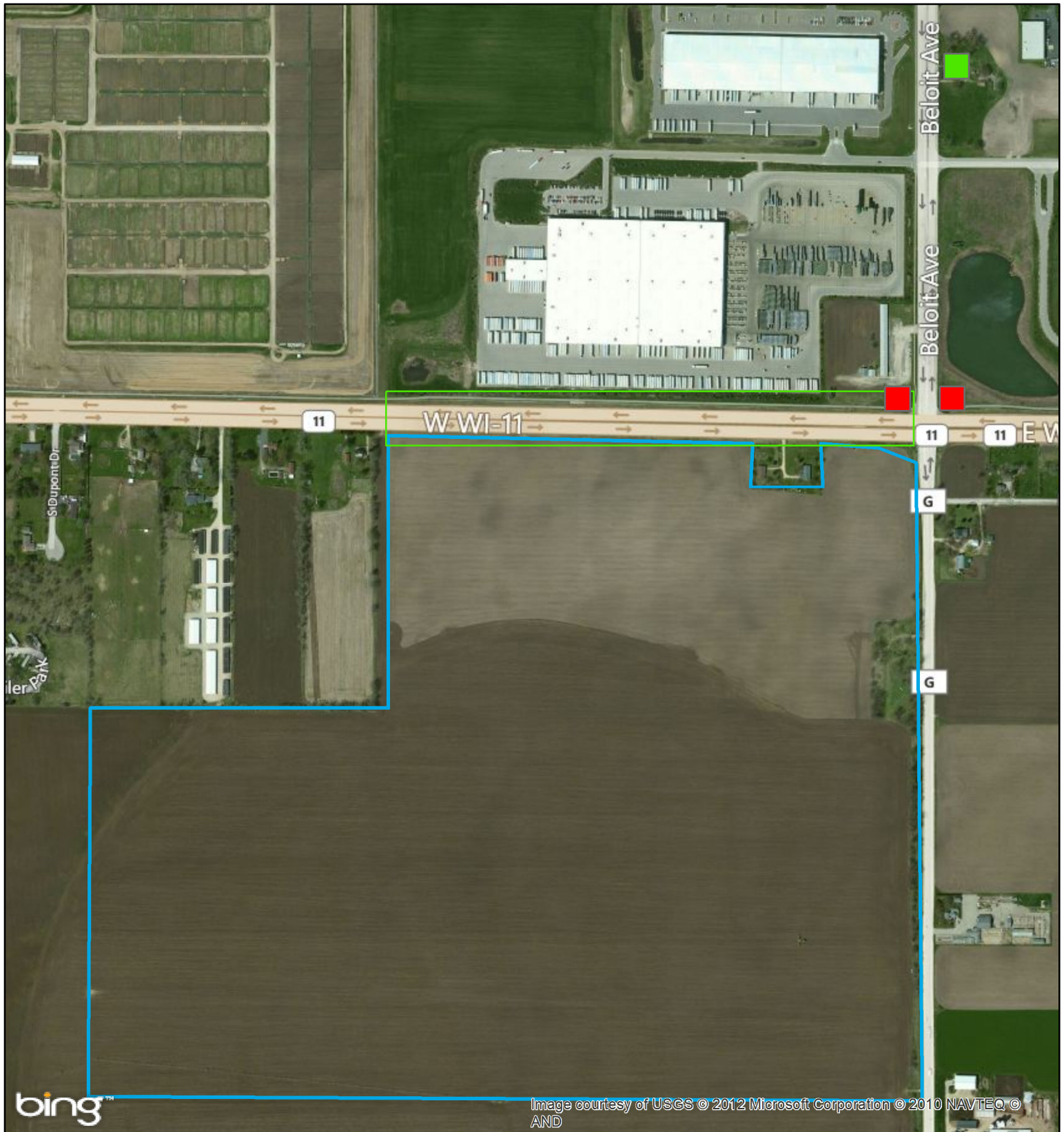
Two historic properties are listed in the AHI adjacent to the project area, 20718 and 86570. One (20718) was the Rockford, Beloit, and Janesville Railway Substation, which is no longer extant. The other (86570) was the Joint School #2, and is also no longer extant. The closest historic property is approximately 0.30 miles north of the project area, at 2739 Beloit Ave. This Italianate house was determined eligible for the NRHP but is not currently listed. The house is far enough from the project area that the proposed project will not have an effect on the property.

No archaeological or burial sites are located within one mile of the project area (Figure 1). One previous survey was completed on along the northern boundary of the project area, along STH 11. The survey was in the right of way and did not result in the location of cultural materials,

As such, no further work is required to satisfy Wis. Stats 157.70 or Wis Stats 44.40. However, if federal funding, permitting, or over site are or become part of the project, a Phase I archaeological and historical investigation will be required by Sections 106 and 110 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 as amended.
