

An Endangered Resources (ER) Review of a proposed land development, management, planning, or similar type of project will provide the requester with information from Wisconsin's Natural Heritage Inventory (NHI) database and other sources on rare plants and animals, high quality natural communities, and other endangered resources that may be impacted by the proposed project. The ER Review will also include specific recommendations to help projects comply with Wisconsin's Endangered Species Law (s. 29.604, Wis. Stats.) and other laws and regulations protecting endangered resources. The minimum fee for an ER Review is \$60, which includes up to three hours of staff time to complete the ER Review. The fee for each additional hour, or any portion thereof, of staff time required to complete the ER Review is \$20 (per NR 29, Wis. Adm. Code). The requester will be invoiced for the total fee upon completion of the ER Review.

Instructions: The following materials are required to process this request. Submit all materials by mail to the address above or by fax (608-266-2925) or email (DNRRERreview@wisconsin.gov). Do not include payment with this form.

- Map(s) delineating the project area, preferably a topographic map and digital orthophoto (aerial photo)

- Additional relevant information and reports (e.g., detailed project and habitat descriptions, wetland delineation, site plans)

Development of the Whitewater University Technology Park will involve the construction of two cul-de-sac streets (totalling approx. 1,000 lf), four stormwater detention basins, construction of a 40,000 sf two story Innovation Center building, the reconstruction of 2,650 feet of Howard Road, and construction of a paved 10-foot wide multiuse trail through the Technology Park. Site related improvements will include storm sewers, water main, and site grading. Land disturbance will be approximately 44.0 acres.


